Institute of Translational Medicine (ITM)

The ITM now has more than 300 residents including UHB and UoB researchers, research professional support, and trainee researchers, from a range of scientific disciplines which include Medicine, Bio/Chemical Engineering, and Computer Science. It houses a cluster of programmes and centres such as NIHR-Biomedical Research Centre, NIHR-SRMRC, Cancer Research UK, D3B, Innovate UK Midlands and Wales Advanced Therapies Treatment Centre, NIHR Global Surgery Centre, HDR-UK Midlands, WM AHSN, Centre for Patient Reported Outcomes Research, Scar Free Foundation Centre for Conflict Wound Research and ERDF MD TEC. More than 2000 staff access the ITM and use the space for multidisciplinary interactions.

One of the core objectives of the ITM was to act as a catalyst for industry, academic and NHS collaborations. The ITM, and its research groups, have so far contributed to the creation of over 1200 jobs and the generation of over £330 million in investment from grants, donations and infrastructure awards.
