### HOSPITALTY DECLARATIONS APRIL 2011 - MARCH 2012

#### PRESENTED BY DIRECTOR OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

#### 1. Introduction

The aim of this paper is to update the Audit Committee on the hospitality, gifts and inducements declared by members of the Board of Directors and the Executive Team on a monthly basis, and those declared by all other members of staff on an annual basis.

#### 2. Process for Declaring Hospitality, Gifts or inducements

2.1 The Board of Directors and the Executive team are required to declare on a monthly basis the acceptance of any Hospitality, Gifts or Inducements with a value in excess of £25. Where no such offers have been received, a nil return must be submitted.

2.2 All members of staff are required to declare any Hospitality, Gifts and Inducements offered with a value in excess of £25 within 30 days of the date of the offer, whether or not the offer was accepted.

#### 3. Returns for April 2011 to March 2012

3.1 The tables below show the returns received for staff for the period of April 2011 to March 2012.

3.2 Please note that since the last report, the only change at Executive Level is that Stuart Dobson and Clare Robinson both left the Trust on 30 September 2011 and David Hamlett and David Waller both joined the Trust on 1 October 2011.

3.3 In certain instances multiple returns for each period have been submitted.

#### 4. Proposal 2012 - 2013

4.1 Declarations are to be submitted by the following:

- 4.1.1 Executive Directors and Non-Executive Directors will be asked each calendar month to submit to the Corporate Affairs Assistant a Declaration including, where appropriate, a nil return.
- 4.1.2 All persons working for the Trust, whether in a clinical or a non-clinical capacity, including all employees of the Trust, volunteers, students, locum staff, agency staff and University staff when engaged in Trust business must submit a Declaration to the Corporate Affairs Assistant within 30 days of the acceptance of a Declarable Gift, Declarable Hospitality or Declarable Sponsorship.
- 4.1.3 In addition, all staff are required to declare if, and to what extent they have been offered and/or accepted any Gifts, Hospitality or Sponsorship from an Interested Third Party when they become involved in any procurement process relating to that Interested Third Party.
- 4.2 It is proposed that the current on-line questionnaire style of recording offers is continued.
- 4.3 It is proposed that the current series of Trust-wide communications are made in different medias thereby ensuring that all Staff are reminded of their duty to submit returns of a Declarable Gift, Declarable Hospitality or Declarable Sponsorship in the event of an offer being made, whether or not it is accepted. These announcements are to be managed by the Corporate Affairs and Communications Teams.
- 4.4 The declaration process will be reviewed each financial year and reported to the Audit Committee.
