



## **Relatives Accommodation**

### Information to help you during your stay on Relatives Wing in Nuffield House Queen Elizabeth Hospital

#### **Welcome to Relatives Accommodation**

Welcome to the Relatives Accommodation in Nuffield House. We hope that you will be comfortable in your room.

The rooms are located on the 2nd floor of the building and the number of the room is on the key tab. There are shared bathrooms, Kitchen and lounge facilities. Unfortunately, we are unable to accommodate children under the age of 16 and animals are not allowed to stay on the wing. The fire alarms within Nuffield House are tested every Wednesday morning. In addition to this, the non-essential electrical supply is tested on the first Wednesday of each month. Please be aware that this may result in a short break of electrical supply.

There is a swipe-card for access through the main doors out of hours and the basement tunnel which links Nuffield House and the main hospital and a lock for the main corridor door. Swipe access is also needed into the Relatives Wing itself.

If you have any problems, or queries, please do not hesitate to contact the Accommodation Manager on ext 14524 during normal office hours, or the porters on ext 12667 out of hours. Please take time to look through this leaflet which should provide you with useful information for your stay. Please use the back of this leaflet to give any comments/feedback to the team.

#### **Payment**

The charge for accommodation including VAT is £45.00 per night for a single stay and £55.00 for a twin stay per night. Please pay daily or weekly for longer stays, by cash or cheque to the Accommodation Manager. Cheques should be made payable to:- **UHB NHS TRUST**.

If you would like to pay by credit card, please telephone our Finance department on 0121 371 7341 or 0121 371 7342 and ask them for a payment reference number to be sent to Karen Roberts or Jenny-Rose Jones.

The cost of staying on the wing goes towards the running of the relatives wing for gas, electricity and water costs. If you would like to make a donation towards items for the wing such as plates, forks etc. then please see Karen and Jenny.

## **Car Parking**

Car-parking on the Queen Elizabeth Hospital site is managed by an external company. If you need to park during your stay, please use the visitors' car-park for which there is a daily charge. If you think that you will be here for a week or longer, you may be interested in applying for a weekly pass. Please see prices for car parking below.

### **Shuttle Bus (bus stop outside front of Nuffield House by Audiology)**

The Q-Park shuttle bus for patients, visitors and relatives picks up and drops off at a number of locations on and near the QEHB, including:

- QEHB main entrance
- Car parks
- University Station
- Birmingham Women's Hospital
- The Barberry and the Oleaster (Birmingham and Solihull Mental Health NHS Foundation Trust)
- Nuffield House

## **Train Station**

University Train Station is a short walk from Nuffield House. Here you will find trains towards Birmingham City Centre, Redditch and Bromsgrove Town Centre a laminated timetable is available next to the telephone in Relatives wing hallway.

## **WiFi**

Wi-fi is free on all hospital sites, click on NHS Wi-Fi and press connect on the link.

## **Where to eat**

Relatives can obtain a voucher from the Accommodation Office for the purchase of meals at staff discount price within our onsite restaurants.

## **Plaza Restaurant**

The Plaza Restaurant and Coffee Shop is located on Level 2 of QEHB and can be accessed by stairs and lifts from The Atrium.

The Plaza Restaurant and Coffee Shop is open from Monday to Sunday from 07:30 – 20:00 with the following serving periods:

- Hot and cold breakfast (07:30 – 11:00)
- Hot food/lunch (12:00 – 14:00)
- Hot food/supper (17:00 – 19:30)

## **ITM Restaurant**

The ITM Restaurant is located in the ITM Building. You can find this across the road from the main entrance of Nuffield House.
