

You may be a patient on the ward who can go home earlier than planned. You may even be a patient in the outpatients department, or Accident and Emergency who has a wound that requires Plastic Surgery input. Or you could be a patient in the community whom we assess and provide clinical support for, aiming to prevent your admission to hospital.

The team of specialist nurses will provide clinical care, support and education to patients, carers and colleagues in the community.

We provide a link between the community teams and the hospital to ensure that your specialist treatment continues to be of the highest standard to assist with your recovery.



The 'Outreach' aspect of the service is to provide specialist nursing care for Plastic Surgery or Burn Injured patient's whilst in hospital, or clinic areas.
